





































Because the Founders did not trust the powers of the government they were creating, they purposely divided its powers, so that no one could wield the powers of all three critical areas.


Although there have been problems, this division has held up over time.





















Create two different governance processes.

•Know that the "voting" process can easily be taken over by elites.

•Know that the "sortition" process means that everyone in a given location will be expected to participate in governance, and will be selected on a random basis. Cannot be taken over by elites.









Create two different governance processes.


•Know that the "National" process can easily be taken over by elites.

•Know that the "village" process means that power can never be "clumped" at a higher level. This means that power always remains at the lowest possible level.














Create two different military processes.

•Know that the "National" military can easily be taken over by elites.

•Make the "national" military small and dependent on participation from the "village" militias.

•A village has to contribute to the "national" military: however, the village may choose to contribute medics, nonviolent peacekeepers, etc. Can opt out of violence.
